**West Camel Parish Council has set up this plan on the recommendation of the Somerset Local Authorities' Civil Contingencies Unit.**

**Aim:** To allow the community to support itself in an emergency. Specifically, shelter during any emergency that affects the community when the normal response by the emergency services is delayed or overwhelmed due to the scope or nature of an incident.

### Emergencies could result from:

- Flooding
- Severe weather
- Fire
- Pollution, e.g. toxic chemicals, spillages, etc.
- Road or air accidents
- Major crime/public disorder

### What you should do in an emergency:

Contact a member of the emergency management team.  
Listen for special warnings or announcements on local radio or TV.  
BBC Somerset: 955 FM. 1566 kHz AM. Orchard FM: 102.6 MHz FM.  
If necessary, contact the emergency services on 999.

In the case of serious flooding turn off mains electricity, gas and water.

If advised to evacuate your home, please do so as quickly as possible, checking that everyone is accounted for.

Check that neighbours are aware of the emergency, especially the elderly, housebound, and those with young children.

Lock doors and windows securely.

If you are able to volunteer to offer any kind of help, please contact a member of the emergency team to find out where help is most needed.



### Emergency supplies:

Sandbags — these are available at the Davis Hall car park.

First aid kits — the Davis Hall.

Refreshments – hot drinks, toilet facilities and heating will be available at the emergency accommodation.
